They will receive information on problem-solving / prevention skills, and share their own experiences in a mostly male setting.

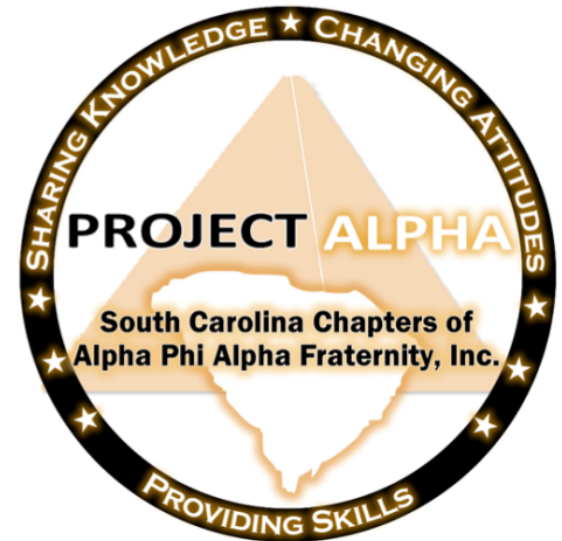
