RULES, CREDENTIALS AND PROTOCOL

- The Official Conference Badge shall be presented to the Sergeant-at-Arms and shall be recognized for admission to all Business Sessions.
- The Official Conference Badge shall be worn and visual during the District Conference.
- District Officers and visiting Officials of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. shall be seated on the first two rows of the assembly.
- Delegates shall be seated in the section of the assembly designated for delegates by the Sergeant-at-Arms and shall be identified by the Conference Badge bearing their name and the “Delegate” designation. Other Brothers shall be seated in the area directly behind the Delegates in the assembly.
- During each Business Session, the District Parliamentarian shall be seated on the dais next to the presiding officer, who will normally be seated to the right of the podium.
- Robert Rules of Order shall govern this District Conference.
- The **required attire** for **ALL** Business Sessions, Public Program, Oratorical Luncheon and the Miss Black & Gold Pageant is:
 1. Suit and Tie
 2. Blazer (Coat) and Tie
 3. No “frat”, “tee”, or “tank top” shirts shall be worn.
 4. No hats or any head cover shall be worn while inside buildings, unless for religious or medical purposes.
 5. No earring(s) shall be worn.

The Sergeant-at-Arms shall deny admission based on inappropriate attire.

- Proper behavior and decorum is requested and expected at all times.
- All cellular phones and electronic devices are to be turned to the “Silent” or “Vibrate” mode. Brothers may not talk on cellular phones or text during Business Sessions or District Conference programs.
- Brothers wishing to participate in floor debate or address the Brothers assembled, must obtain the attention of the Chair, approach the designated area, and identify themselves by Name and Chapter prior to addressing the body.
- South Carolina District Parliamentarian is Brother Mickle A. Haynes, South Carolina District Sergeant-at-Arms is Brother Larry J. Stevens.






